



# Secondary MFL Line Manager (Webinar) 25-26

**9 October 2025      15:30-17:00**

This webinar is aimed at senior leadership team (SLT) members with a limited background in MFL teaching who will be line managing heads of MFL during 2025-26. The main objective of this session is to ensure that line managers are aware of the key ingredients required to lead a successful languages department. This will enable them to support and challenge subject leaders in the delivery of a successful MFL curriculum in their context.

Additionally, HIAS MFL advisers will be able to establish contact and make senior leaders aware of the support on offer to schools including MFL network meetings, school visits and ECT provision. The planning and teaching resources on the Moodle will also be highlighted in these sessions.
