



Secondary MFL ECT+ Webinar Programme 2024-25

This series of bespoke half-termly webinars are designed to support MFL secondary ECTs in the early years of their careers as language teachers.

Led by experienced Hampshire MFL Heads of Department, the sessions will cover current areas of language teaching pedagogy from lesson planning, to scaffolding and assessment, with a focus on the new GCSE curriculum. The webinars will culminate in a day's in-person conference in July 2025, to enable teachers to reflect on their progress and plan their next steps.

Our aims:

The course will deliver less experienced MFL teachers up-to-date CPD to support their sustained success in the classroom. The key ingredients of an excellent language teacher will be explored in detail, as we consider routines, planning and teaching to ensure all pupils make progress. This course will also provide a network of support for teachers to discuss MFL pedagogy and share ideas, which may be particularly useful to those with limited subject specialist support in school.
