Our aims:

The profile of MFL in the KS3 and 4 curriculum continues to increase, with schools needing to increase uptake towards the government's EBacc aspiration, but often finding it challenging to attract a broad range of students to what has often been seen as a challenging and, at times, elitist subject.

This bespoke online session will give SLT line managers an overview of the current issues and challenges particular to MFL teaching. With a focus on curriculum and assessment, we will identify the key ingredients for raising EBACC uptake whilst ensuring positive progress through excellent subject leadership.

The agenda:

- **The intent and development of a successful MFL curriculum:** Comparing different curriculum models, adapting them to individual contexts and planning for progression for all students.
- **The EBACC and raising GCSE uptake:** Exploration of key factors contributing to uptake at KS4; Making the GCSE course accessible to SEND and disadvantaged pupils.
- **Being prepared for the new MFL GCSE – what good teaching looks like:** Focus on the 3 pillars (vocabulary, phonics and grammar); Developing techniques to embed structures and vocabulary in the classroom.
- **Supporting and challenging MFL leadership:** Driving progress and achievement.
- **Formative and summative assessment in MFL:** Adapting the assessment of listening, speaking, reading and writing to your school's assessment policy; preparing students for assessments.
- **Further support in MFL:** Exam boards and associations offering CPD; HIAS MFL support for HODS and ECTs.
